

BRONAUGH R-7 SCHOOL
ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY FOR COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE

The Bronaugh R-7 School is providing Internet access to the students and staff. The service is provided through MoreNet. This network is designed, installed, and operated for educational purposes only. Educational purposes are defined as classroom activities, professional or career development, and high-quality research.

Signing the Acceptable Use Policy becomes an agreement between the school, the staff, the student, and the student's parent or guardian. It explains responsibilities when using computer equipment and the Internet and the consequence(s) of abusing the privilege.

Prohibited Activities:

- Students may not use a computer unless a staff member is present.
- Students may not set up or access e-mail accounts or be allowed in chat rooms.
- Students may not install any programs not directly authorized by the technology staff.
- Students may not adjust or change computer settings without permission.
- Students may not download any files or programs from the Internet without the teacher's permission.
- Your school computer files are not private and your teacher or technology director may see them at any time.
- Students may not plagiarize work that they find on the Internet.

Plagiarism is taking the ideas of others and presenting them as your own. Respect copyright laws and identify materials that you use.

STUDENT PENALTIES FOR TECHNOLOGY VIOLATIONS

First Offense: Loss of Internet access and computer use for 9 weeks.

Second Offense: Loss of Internet access and computer use for the school year.

Third Offense: Loss of Inter access and computer sue for the remainder of attendance at Bronaugh R-7 School.

MAJOR VIOLATIONS MAY LEAD TO MORE SEVERE PENALTIES AND LEGAL ACTION.

STAFF USER AGREEMENT

I will instruct students on acceptable use of the equipment and Internet. I understand that it is my responsibility to design lessons or other student activities if they are allowed to use the Internet; I know I am not to use the Internet for personal use during student contact time.

I know Bronaugh School can monitor my Internet use, and if I do anything illegal, the school may contact legal authorities.
